Board Corner

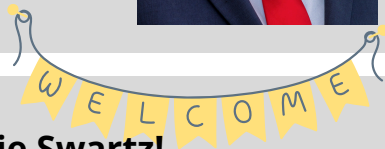
Dear Coastline ROP Community,

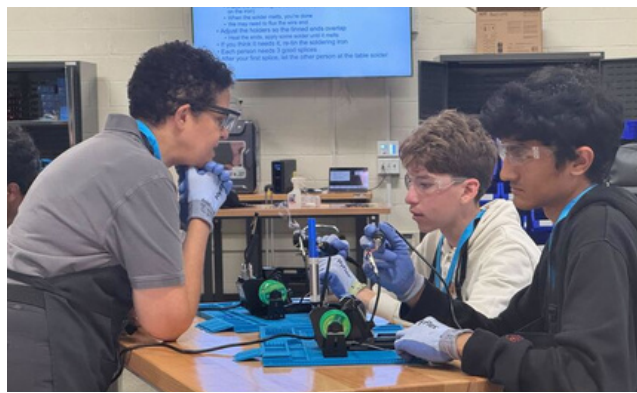


Welcome, Susie Swartz!
